Revocation of National Roads Board Bylaw 1977, No 1

(SR 1978/224)

Revocation of National Roads Board Bylaw 1977, No 1: revoked, on 6 November 2008, by clause 3 of the Regulations Revocation Order 2008 (SR 2008/367).

PURSUANT to the National Roads Act 1953, the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, and the Counties Act 1956, the National Roads Board hereby revokes the National Roads Board Bylaw 1977, No 1¹. This revocation was made by resolution passed at a meeting of the National Roads Board, held in Wellington on the 19th day of July 1978.
