# **Regulations Revocation Order 1999**

(SR 1999/402)

Regulations Revocation Order 1999: revoked, on 6 November 2008, by clause 3 of the Regulations Revocation Order 2008 (SR 2008/367).

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, revokes spent regulations. Some of the revoked regulations were administered in the Ministry of Commerce and others in the Department of Labour. The revocations are part of the Government's *Bright Future Package*, which includes a regulatory stocktake to identify and remove redundant legislation.
