1 **Title**

(1) These regulations are the Shipping (Charges) Amendment Regulations 2004.

(2) In these regulations, the Shipping (Charges) Regulations 2000¹ are called "the principal regulations".

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 8 August 2004.

3 Charges for seafarer certificates, permits, and endorsements

Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following subclause:

"(2) If a charge for the recognition of a particular non-New Zealand certificate is not specified in Schedule 2, the charge for the recognition of that certificate is the same as the charge for the equivalent New Zealand certificate."

(1) Schedule 1 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the item Safety audits under the heading Audits, the following item:
