Pursuant to section 132 of the Social Security Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

These regulations are administered by the Ministry of Social Development.

Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Social Security (Period of Income Assessment) Amendment Regulations 2013.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force immediately after the commencement, on 15 July 2013, of section 86 and Part 2 of Schedule 3 of the Social Security (Benefit Categories and Work Focus) Amendment Act 2013.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Social Security (Period of Income Assessment) Regulations 1996 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Schedule amended

In the Schedule, clause 1, item relating to jobseeker support (as that item is inserted by section 86 and Part 2 of Schedule 3 of the Social Security (Benefit Categories and Work Focus) Amendment Act 2013), replace “clause 1(ab) or (ba)” with “clause 1(ab), (ba), or (c)”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Social Security (Period of Income Assessment) Regulations 1996, and come into force immediately after the commencement, on 15 July 2013, of section 86 and Part 2 of Schedule 3 of the Social Security (Benefit Categories and Work Focus) Amendment Act 2013.

The amendment relates to jobseeker support paid at the rate (for a single beneficiary with 1 or more dependent children) in clause 1(c) of Schedule 9 of the Social Security Act 1964.

The amendment ensures, for jobseeker support paid at that rate, that a person’s weekly income is determined under section 64(2A) of that Act by dividing by 52 the person’s total income over a 52-week period. However, the chief executive may, with the person’s agreement, instead determine that person’s income over the period of 1 week.
