Transport Organisation Membership Regulations Revocation Order 1984: revoked, on 6 November 2008, by clause 3 of the Regulations Revocation Order 2008 (SR 2008/367).

PURSUANT to paragraphs (t) and (u) of section 186 and section 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Transport Organisation Membership Regulations Revocation Order 1984.

Note

This order is administered in the Ministry of Transport.

- (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1984.

2 Revocations

- (1) The Transport Organisation Membership Regulations 1941¹ are hereby revoked; and all approvals and notices given by the Minister under those regulations, and any conditions deemed to be part of any transport licence by regulation 4(2) of those regulations, shall cease to have effect accordingly.
- (2) The Transport Organisation Membership Regulations 1941, Amendment No 1² and the Transport Organisation Membership Regulations 1941, Amendment No 2³ are hereby consequentially revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order revokes the Transport Organisation Membership Regulations 1941 with effect on and from 1 June 1984.

The effect of the revoked regulations is that the holder of a transport licence of a class that makes the holder eligible for membership of
