**Transport (Breath Tests) Amendment Notice 1999
(SR 1999/19)**

Transport (Breath Tests) Amendment Notice 1999: revoked, on 3 February 2010, pursuant to clause 9 of the Land Transport (Breath Tests) Notice 2009 (SR 2009/386).

Pursuant to sections 2 and 218 of the Land Transport Act 1998, the Minister of Police gives the following notice.

Notice

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Breath Tests) Amendment Notice 1999, and is part of the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No 2) 1989 (SR 1989/389) (“the principal notice”).
- (2) This notice comes into force on 1 March 1999.

2 Interpretation

Clause 2 of the principal notice is amended by revoking the definition of the term **enforcement officer**, and substituting the following definition:

enforcement officer means the enforcement officer (within the meaning of section 2 of the Land Transport Act 1998) who is conducting the test.

Changes authorised by subpart 2 of Part 3 of the Legislation Act 2019 have been made in this consolidation. See the notes at the end of this consolidation for further details.

This notice is administered by the New Zealand Police.

3 Approval of conclusive evidential breath-testing devices

Clause 8 of the principal notice is amended by omitting the words “section 58(5) of the Transport Act 1962”, and substituting the words “section 77(5) of the Land Transport Act 1998”.
