2 Commencement of War Pensions Amendment Act 2009

The War Pensions Amendment Act 2009 comes into force on 5 January 2010.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force on 5 January 2010 the War Pensions Amendment Act 2009, which amends the War Pensions Act 1954 so as to enable in some circumstances the payment of veteran's pensions to people who are overseas.

Notes

1 *General*

This is a consolidation of the War Pensions Amendment Act 2009 Commencement Order 2009 that incorporates the amendments made to the legislation so that it shows the law as at its stated date.

2 *Legal status*

A consolidation is taken to correctly state, as at its stated date, the law enacted or made by the legislation consolidated and by the amendments. This presumption applies unless the contrary is shown.
