Aquaculture Legislation Amendment Bill (No 3)

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 4 Bills

Hon Phil Heatley, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, *Part 1*, *and Schedule 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Aquaculture Reform (Repeals and Transitional Provisions) Amendment Act **2011**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 October 2011.

That *Part 2* and *Schedules 1A and 1B* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Fisheries Amendment Act **2011**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 October 2011.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Maori Commercial Aquaculture Claims Settlement Amendment Act 2011.

2 Commencement

- Section 52(2) and (3) comes into force on the day on which (1) this Act receives the Royal assent.
- The rest of this Act comes into force on 1 October 2011. (2)

That Part 4 and Schedules 2 and 3 be a separate Bill, and that for the Part 4 heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

This Act is the Resource Management Amendment Act **2011**.

Commencement 2

- Section 69 comes into force 3 years after the date on which (1) this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on 1 October 2011.
