Proposed amendments

Mark Cameron, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 13

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(a)(i) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 4), insert "subject to the quota management system".

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(a)(ii) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 6), insert "subject to the quota management system".

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(b)(i) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 9), insert "subject to the quota management system".

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(b)(ii) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 11), insert "subject to the quota management system".

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(c)(i) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 15), insert "subject to the quota management system".

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(c)(ii) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 17), insert "subject to the quota management system".

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(d)(i) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 21), insert "subject to the quota management system".

In clause 13(1), new subsection (4)(d)(ii) of section 72, after "that are aquatic life" (page 9, line 23), insert "subject to the quota management system".

#### Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Fisheries Amendment Bill. It would ensure so-called "bait fish" or very common fish, which can be caught in very large numbers, are excluded from the list. This would mean that the limit of 50 fish is

limited to valuable fish which are already listed in the quota management system. This also aligns the system.
