**Intelligence and Security Bill**

*Proposed amendments*

Andrew Little, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 156*

In *clause 156(1)(b)* (page 116, line 24), replace “7” with “9”.

In *clause 156(4)* (page 116, line 37), replace “6 or 7” with “more than 5”.

In *clause 156(4)(a)* (page 116, line 38), replace “2” with “2 or 3”.

In *clause 156(5)*, after “security requirements” (page 117, lines 5), insert “and the proportional representation of political parties in the House of Representatives”.

**Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper increases the maximum size of the Intelligence and Security Committee from 7 to 9 and ensures proportional representation on the committee. As *clause 156* is currently drafted it does not provide for proportional representation of all political parties of a reasonable size. This amendment addresses that by increasing the maximum size of the committee and ensuring proportional representation on the committee.
