New Part 13

To add the following new clause (on page 87):

434 Interpretation

The definition of **fine** in section 141AD is amended by adding the following paragraph:

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Immigration Bill and Supplementary Order Paper No 32 (which amends the Immigration Bill). The amendment relating to the District Courts Act 1947 (which altered the maximum number of District Court Judges from 140 to 141) will be addressed in a separate Ministry of Justice bill amending that Act.

All the other amendments are consequential to matters contained in the Sentencing (Offender Levy) Amendment Bill.
