#### Land Transport (Clean Vehicles) Amendment Bill

#### Proposed amendments

Hon Michael Wood, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 7: new section 172(1)

In clause 7, new section 172(1), replace the definition of **new** (page 11, lines 10 to 23) with:

**new**, in relation to a light vehicle, means a vehicle that is not a used vehicle

In clause 7, new section 172(1), delete the definition of **registration** (page 11, line 26).

In clause 7, new section 172(1), replace the definition of **used** (page 12, lines 10 to 21) with:

**used**, in relation to a light vehicle, means a vehicle that has been registered under any of the following:

- (a) Part 17 of this Act:
- (b) the Transport Act 1962:
- (c) the Transport (Vehicle and Driver Registration and Licensing) Act 1986:
- (d) any corresponding enactment of another country

#### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Land Transport (Clean Vehicles) Amendment Bill by replacing the definitions of the terms new and used, as used in the Bill in relation to a light vehicle. As a consequence of these amendments, a definition of the term registration is no longer required and is therefore deleted.
