**Marine and Coastal Area (Takutai Moana) Bill**

*Proposed amendment*

Hilary Calvert, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

*Clause 27*

To add the following subclause (after line 35 on page 31):

- (5) To avoid doubt, neither a customary marine title group nor applicant group is entitled to charge or collect fees or other form of payment from any person or body to access, stay in or on, and engage in any recreational activities on any part of the common marine and coastal area.

**Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Bill to ensure that no individual or group may be charged for access to the common marine and coastal area. It is based on the similar prohibition on charging contained in the existing Fore-shore and Seabed Act, which draws a distinction between an “individual” and a “body”. The Supplementary Order Paper proposed by the Attorney-General does not do this, and mentions only the “individual”. This Supplementary Order Paper replaces SOP No 210.
