**Māori Purposes Bill**

---

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 4 Bills*

Hon Georgina te Heuheu, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

This Act is the Māori Purposes Act **2011**.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

This Act is the Maori Fisheries Amendment Act **2011**.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:****1 Title**

This Act is the Maori Trust Boards Amendment Act **2011**.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4* and *the Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 4* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:****1 Title**

This Act is—

- (a) Te Ture Whenua Maori Amendment Act **2011**; or
- (b) the Maori Land Amendment Act **2011**.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
