Clause 38

In clause 38, after paragraph (a) (page 23, after line 28), insert:

(aa) ensure that they have as a key priority the need to support improved outcomes for children and young people, with particular attention to the need to support improved outcomes for Māori children and young people; and

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Oversight of Oranga Tamariki System and Children and Young People's Commission Bill.
