Objectionable Publications and Indecency Legisla-
tion Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 5 Bills

Hon Judith Collins, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *subpart 1 of Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1 and subpart 1 headings* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Films, Videos, and Publications Classification (Objectionable Publications) Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *subpart 2 of Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that the *subpart 2 heading* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Customs and Excise (Objectionable Publications) Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *subpart 1 of Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 2 and subpart 1 headings* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Crimes (Indecency) Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *subpart 2 of Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that the *subpart 2 heading* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Accident Compensation (Cover for Mental Injury—Indecency Offences) Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *subpart 3 of Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that the *subpart 3 heading* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Vulnerable Children (Children’s Worker Safety Checking—Indecency Offence) Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
