## **Smoke-free Environments (Prohibiting Smoking in Motor Vehicles Carrying Children) Amendment Bill**

### *Proposed amendments*

Hon Jenny Salesa, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

#### *Clause 9*

In *clause 9*, replace *new section 20D(2)(b)* (page 3, line 26) with:

- (b) the motor vehicle is—
  - (i) manufactured for use as an occasional or permanent dwelling; and
  - (ii) stationary on a road and in use as a dwelling.

In *clause 9*, replace *new section 20E(3)* (page 5, lines 1 to 3) with:

- (3) Despite **subsection (1)**, a constable must not take either of the actions referred to in **subsection (1)(c) and (d)** if the motor vehicle is—
  - (a) manufactured for use as an occasional or permanent dwelling; and
  - (b) stationary on a road and in use as a dwelling.

### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Smoke-free Environments (Prohibiting Smoking in Motor Vehicles Carrying Children) Amendment Bill to narrow the exemption for smoking in motor vehicles that are stationary on a road and in use as a dwelling.

The exemption will apply only to motor vehicles that are manufactured for use as an occasional or permanent dwelling, as well as being stationary on a road and in use as a dwelling.
