## Security Information in Proceedings Legislation Bill

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills*

Hon Kiritapu Allan, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, Parts 1 to 3, and Schedules 1 and 2* be a separate Bill, and that the enacting words and *clauses 1 and 2* be replaced with:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

This Act is the Security Information in Proceedings Act **2022**.

**2 Commencement**

(1) This Act comes into force on—

- (a) the first anniversary of the date of Royal assent; or
- (b) an earlier date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.

(2) An Order in Council made under this section is secondary legislation (*see* Part 3 of the Legislation Act 2019 for publication requirements).

That *Part 4 and Schedules 3 to 9* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 4* heading be replaced with:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

This Act is the Security Information in Proceedings (Repeals and Amendments) Act **2022**.

**2 Commencement**

(1) This Act comes into force on—

- (a) the first anniversary of the date of Royal assent; or
  - (b) an earlier date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.
- (2) An Order in Council made under this section is secondary legislation (*see* Part 3 of the Legislation Act 2019 for publication requirements).
