## Three Strikes Legislation Repeal Bill

### *Proposed amendments*

Hon Kiritapu Allan, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

#### *Clause 2 amended*

In *clause 2*, replace “**1 July 2022**” with “the day after the date of Royal assent” (page 3, line 5).

#### *New clause 20A inserted*

After *clause 20* (page 5, after line 12), insert:

**20A Section 88 amended (Chief executive must determine key dates, etc)**

After section 88(3), insert:

- (4) A determination made under this section must be made as if the Three Strikes Legislation Repeal Act **2021** had not been enacted.

#### *Schedule: new Part 4*

In the *Schedule*, *new Part 4*, replace *clause 13(2)* (page 9, lines 10 to 23) with:

- (2) If this clause applies, the person is not eligible for release or re-sentencing as a consequence of any provision brought into force under the Three Strikes Legislation Repeal Act **2021**.

### Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper changes the commencement date of the Bill from 1 July 2022 to the day after the date of Royal assent. In addition, it inserts *new clause 20A*, which provides that determinations made under section 88 of the Parole Act 2002 must be made as if the Three Strikes Legislation Repeal Bill were not enacted.

As a consequence, it also amends *clause 13(2) of new Part 4 of the Schedule* to simplify the relevant transitional provision.
