Te Ture Whenua Māori Bill

Proposed amendment to SOP No 279

Hon Te Ururoa Flavell, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

*New clause 327A and cross-heading*After *clause 327* (page 242), insert:

Review of Act

327A Review of Act

- (1) The Minister must, as soon as practicable after the seventh anniversary of the date on which all of **Parts 1 to 9** have commenced, start a review of the operation and effectiveness of **Parts 1 to 9** in accordance with the terms of reference set by the Minister.
- (2) The Minister must—
 - (a) prepare a report on the review; and
 - (b) present the report to the House of Representatives within 18 months after the start of the review.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends SOP No 279, which amends Te Ture Whenua Māori Bill. The amendment inserts a new provision into the part of the Bill that will become Te Ture Whenua Māori Act 2017. The provision requires the Minister to start a review of the operation and effectiveness of that Act as soon as practicable after the seventh anniversary of the date on which all of the Act has commenced. The Minister must prepare a report on the review and present it to the House of Representatives.
