Victims of Crime Reform Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 4 Bills

Hon Judith Collins, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Victims' Rights Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Section 30** comes into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force 6 months after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 2* heading be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force 6 months after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 3* heading be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

This Act is the Parole Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force 6 months after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 4* heading be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

This Act is the Sentencing Amendment Act **2014**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force 6 months after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
