#### **Arms Legislation Bill**

Proposed amendments

Hon Stuart Nash, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

#### Clause 6

In *clause 6(1)*, before the new definition of **ammunition seller** (page 10, before line 3), insert:

air pistol carbine conversion kit means a frame or kit that may be used to convert an air pistol designed or adapted to be held and fired with 1 hand into an airgun that may be fired from the shoulder

- (d) is suitable for shooting on a certified pistol range

**pistol** means any firearm (other than a prohibited firearm) that is designed or adapted to be held and fired with 1 hand, and includes any firearm (other than a prohibited firearm) that is less than 762 millimetres in length

#### 2A Meaning of prohibited firearm

- (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, **prohibited fire-arm**
  - (a) means any of the following firearms:
    - (i) a semi-automatic firearm, other than—
      - (A) a specified semi-automatic firearm:
      - (B) a semi-automatic shotgun with a non-detachable tubular magazine or magazines that are capable of holding no more than 5 cartridges commensurate with that firearm's chamber size:
      - (C) a small semi-automatic pistol:
    - (ii) a pump-action shotgun that is capable of being used with a detachable magazine:
    - (iii) a pump-action shotgun that has a non-detachable tubular magazine or magazines that are capable of holding more than 5 cartridges commensurate with that firearm's chamber size:
  - (b) includes any other firearm declared by Order in Council made under section 74A to be a prohibited firearm for the purposes of this Act.

- (2) In this section, **specified semi-automatic firearm** means a semi-automatic firearm—
  - (a) that is capable of firing only 0.22 calibre or lower rimfire cartridges and that has a magazine, whether or not detachable or otherwise externally fed, that is capable of holding no more than 10 cartridges commensurate with the firearm's chamber size; and
  - (b) if the firearm has a lower receiver, the lower receiver is not capable of—
    - (i) being attached to a centrefire upper receiver; or
    - (ii) being able to accept and cycle centrefire cartridges or rimfire cartridges greater than 0.22 calibre.

#### 6B Section 2B amended (Meaning of prohibited magazine)

- (1) A member of the Police to whom an application is made for the issue of a permit for the purposes of **section 16(1)(e)** may require the applicant to produce for examination and testing samples of any pistol carbine conversion kit of the kind referred to in the application that the member of the Police considers necessary.
- (2) The Commissioner may grant an application for the issue of a permit to bring or cause to be brought or sent into New Zealand a pistol carbine conversion kit only if—
  - (a) the Commissioner is satisfied that—
    - (i) there are special reasons why the pistol carbine conversion kit should be allowed into New Zealand; and
    - (ii) the pistol carbine conversion kit specifically enables a pistol to be converted into a firearm that—
      - (A) has an overall length of greater than 400 millimetres, but less than 762 millimetres; and
      - (B) has a muzzle velocity of 1,600 feet per second or less; and
    - (iii) the pistol carbine conversion kit does not modify the pistol in any way other than as specified in **subparagraph (ii)**; and

- (b) the application is made by—
  - (i) the holder of a dealer's licence who is acting as an agent for a person who holds a firearms licence that bears an endorsement made under section 30 permitting the person to possess a pistol, and—
    - (A) the holder's licence bears an endorsement made under section 30 permitting the holder to possess a pistol; and
    - (B) the holder has been issued with a permit to import a pistol (under section 18) or a permit to possess a pistol (under section 35); or
  - (ii) the holder of a firearms licence—
    - (A) whose licence bears an endorsement made under section 30 permitting the holder to posses a pistol; and
    - (B) who has been issued with a permit to import a pistol (under section 18) or a permit to possess a pistol (under section 35).
- (3) Any permit issued under this section for the purposes of **section 16(1)(e)** is personal to the person to whom it is issued and may not be transferred to any other person.

#### 18AAB Issue of permit to import air pistol carbine conversion kits

- (1) A member of the Police to whom an application is made for the issue of a permit for the purposes of **section 16(1)(f)** may require the applicant to produce for examination and testing samples of any air pistol carbine conversion kit of the kind referred to in the application that the member of the Police considers necessary.
- (2) The Commissioner may grant an application for the issue of a permit to bring or cause to be brought or sent into New Zealand an air pistol carbine conversion kit only if the Commissioner is satisfied that the application is made by—
  - (a) the holder of a dealer's licence who is acting as an agent for a person who intends to personally use the kit as a member of an airsoft or paintball club that is affiliated with a national airsoft or paintball organisation; or
  - (b) any other person who intends to personally use the kit as a member of an airsoft or paintball club that is affiliated with a national airsoft or paintball organisation.
- (3) Any permit issued under this section for the purposes of **section 16(1)(f)** is personal to the person to whom it is issued and may not be transferred to any other person.

#### 18AAC Revocation and validity of permit to import

- (1) A permit issued under section 18, **18AA**, or **18AAB** for the purposes of **section 16(1)** may be revoked at any time by a commissioned officer of Police.
- (2) A permit issued under section 18 or **18AA** is automatically revoked if—
  - (a) the permit was issued to a licensed dealer and the dealer's licence is revoked or suspended, or has expired or been surrendered; or
  - (b) the permit was issued to any other person who, for the purposes of the issue of the permit was required to hold a firearms licence, or a firearms licence bearing an endorsement, and that person's firearms licence or endorsement is revoked or suspended, or has expired or been surrendered.
- (3) Subsection (4) applies if—
  - (a) a permit is issued under section 18 or **18AA** for the purposes of **section 16(1)** to a licensed dealer permitting the dealer to import items on the behalf of 1 or more persons; and
  - (b) any person referred to in **paragraph (a)** who is required to hold a firearms licence, or a firearms licence bearing an endorsement, to possess an item being imported on their behalf has their licence or endorsement revoked or suspended, or their licence or endorsement expires or is surrendered.
- (4) If this subsection applies, the permit issued to the licensed dealer is invalid to the extent that it permits the importation of an item on behalf of a person referred to in **subsection (3)(b)** in respect of which the person required the licence or endorsement.

### 18AAD Permit to import issued for single consignment of items brought into or sent into New Zealand at same time

- (1) A permit may be issued under section 18, **18AA**, or **18AAB** in relation to items that are to be brought or sent into New Zealand in a single consignment at the same time.
- (2) If, subsequent to the issue of a permit referred to in subsection (1), any item to which the permit relates is not included in the consignment, the permit ceases to apply to that item.

    - (A) been issued under section 18 a permit to import a pistol; or

    - (A) been issued under **section 18AA** a permit to import a pistol carbine conversion kit; or
    - (B) been issued under **section 35AA** a permit to possess a pistol carbine conversion kit.

- (2) A permit to possess a pistol carbine conversion kit may be issued if the member of the Police to whom the application is made is satisfied—

- (a) that the applicant—
  - (i) holds a dealer's licence that bears an endorsement made under section 30 permitting the holder to possess a pistol; and
  - (ii) has been issued with—
    - (A) a permit, under section 18, to import a pistol; or
    - (B) a permit, under section 35, to possess a pistol; or
- (b) that the applicant (not being an employee of a licensed dealer)—
  - (i) holds a firearms licence that bears an endorsement made under section 30 permitting the holder to possess a pistol; and
  - (ii) has been issued with—
    - (A) a permit, under section 18, to import a pistol; or
    - (B) a permit, under section 35, to possess a pistol.
- (3) The member of the Police to whom the application is made must also be satisfied that—
  - (a) the pistol carbine conversion kit specifically enables a pistol to be converted into a firearm that—
    - (i) has an overall length of greater than 400 millimetres, but less than 762 millimetres; and
    - (ii) has a muzzle velocity of 1,600 feet per second or less; and
  - (b) the pistol carbine conversion kit does not modify the pistol in any way other than as specified in **paragraph (a)**.
- (4) Unless sooner revoked, a permit issued under this section remains in force for the period specified in the permit, which must not exceed 1 month.
- (5) A permit may at any time be revoked by a commissioned officer of Police.

    - (ii) under the immediate supervision of another person (**B**) who holds a firearms licence that bears an endorsement made under section 30 permitting B to possess a pistol; and
  - (b) that at all times while A was in possession of the pistol carbine conversion kit A was—
    - (i) on a certified pistol range; and
    - (ii) under the immediate supervision of B.

In section 73(1)(a) and (b), after "prohibited part," insert "a pistol carbine conversion kit,".

#### Clause 82

After clause 82(6) (page 62, after line 27), insert:

(6A) In section 74(1)(i) and (j), after "restricted weapons,", insert "pistol carbine conversion kits,".

In *clause 82(1)*, *new section 74(1)(rd)*, after "restricted weapons," (page 64, line 22), insert "pistol carbine conversion kits,".

New clause 82A

After clause 82 (page 64, after line 22), insert:

- 82A Section 74A amended (Order in Council relating to definitions of prohibited firearm and prohibited magazine, and declaring prohibited ammunition)
- (1) Replace section 74A(a) with:
  - (a) amend the description in **section 2A** of a semi-automatic firearm (except a small semi-automatic pistol) or pumpaction shotgun that is a prohibited firearm:
- (2) Replace section 74A(c) with:
  - (c) declare any semi-automatic firearm (except a small semiautomatic pistol) or pump-action firearm of a stated name or description to be a prohibited firearm for the purposes of this Act:

#### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper sets out amendments to the Arms Legislation Bill. The following amendments are made to the Bill:

- the definition of prohibited firearm in the Arms Act 1983 is replaced and the new definition clarifies that a semi-automatic firearm that has a lower receiver capable of being attached to a centrefire upper receiver is a prohibited firearm even if the firearm is capable of firing only 0.22 calibre or lower rimfire cartridges (clause 6 and new clause 6A):
- the definition of prohibited firearm in the Arms Act 1983 as replaced by *new clause 6A* includes as a prohibited firearm a semi-automatic pistol that is not a short pistol:
- the power to amend, by Order in Council, the description of a semi-automatic firearm that is a prohibited firearm is changed to include pistols, as certain semi-automatic pistols are now semi-automatic firearms (new clause 82A(1)):
- the power to declare, by Order in Council, any pump-action shotgun to be a prohibited firearm is amended so that this power applies to all types of pump-action firearms, in particular pump-action centrefire rifles (new clause 82A(2)):
- definitions of pistol carbine conversion kit and air pistol carbine conversion kit are inserted in section 2(1) of the Arms Act 1983 (*clause 6*):
- the importation, sale, supply, possession, and use of pistol carbine conversion kits is restricted to persons holding a dealer's licence or a firearms licence that bears an endorsement permitting the person to possess a pistol and having an appropriate permit (clauses 7, 10, new clause 10A, 11, 14 to 18, 21, 24, new clause 24A, 25, 26, 31, new clause 37A, 40, 43, new clause 48A, new clause 50A, 55, 57, 62, new clause 64A, 70, 74, 76, new clauses 76A and 77A, 79, 80, new clauses 80A and 81A, and clause 82):
- the importation and manufacture of air pistol carbine conversion kits is restricted (*clause 11 and new clause 24A*).
