David Seymour, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

New clause 18A

After clause 18 (page 10, after line 26), insert:

#### 18A Complaints about enforcement officers

- (1) Any person may complain to the Director-General about the conduct of an enforcement officer (other than a constable) in exercising any of the powers conferred by or under this Act.
- (2) After receiving a complaint, the Director-General must investigate the complaint as soon as practicable.

#### Clause 19

Replace the heading to *clause 19* (page 10, line 27) with "Evidence of identity and right to complain"

In clause 19(b) replace "." (page 10, line 32) with "; and".

After clause 19(b) (page 10, after line 32), insert:

(c) a written statement setting out a person's rights under the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990 and the right to make a complaint to the Director-General under section 18A.
