Crown Minerals (Permitting and Crown Land) Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 5 Bills

Hon Simon Bridges, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, Part 1, and Schedules 1A to 4* be a separate Bill, and that the enacting words, *clauses 1 to 3, and the Part 1 heading* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Crown Minerals Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the earlier of the following:

- (a) the date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council:
- (b) the date that is 2 years after the date on which the Act receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act

This Act amends the Crown Minerals Act 1991 (the **principal Act**).

That Part 2 be a separate Bill, and that the Part 2 heading and clause 55 be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Conservation Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the earlier of the following:

- (a) the date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council:
- (b) the date that is 2 years after the date on which the Act receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act

This Act amends the Conservation Act 1987 (the **principal Act**).

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 3 heading and clause 59* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Continental Shelf Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the earlier of the following:

- (a) the date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council:
- (b) the date that is 2 years after the date on which the Act receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act

This Act amends the Continental Shelf Act 1964 (the **principal Act**).

That *Part 4* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 4 heading and clause 63* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Reserves Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the earlier of the following:

- (a) the date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council:
- (b) the date that is 2 years after the date on which the Act receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act

This Act amends the Reserves Act 1977 (the **principal Act**).

That *Part 5* be a separate Bill, and that the *Part 5 heading and clause 70* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Wildlife Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the earlier of the following:

- (a) the date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council:
- (b) the date that is 2 years after the date on which the Act receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act

This Act amends the Wildlife Act 1953 (the **principal Act**).

Explanatory note

The motion set out in this Supplementary Order Paper divides the Crown Minerals (Permitting and Crown Land) Bill into the following 5 Bills:

- Crown Minerals Amendment Bill:
- Conservation Amendment Bill (No 2):
- Continental Shelf Amendment Bill:
- Reserves Amendment Bill:
- Wildlife Amendment Bill.

Part 1 and Schedules 1A to 4 become the Crown Minerals Amendment Bill. Part 2 becomes the Conservation Amendment Bill (No 2). Part 3 becomes the Continental Shelf Amendment Bill. Part 4 becomes the Reserves Amendment Bill and Part 5 becomes the Wildlife Amendment Bill.
