Domestic Violence (Enhancing Safety) Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 3 Bills

Hon Simon Power, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, *Part 1*, *and the Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Domestic Violence Amendment Act **2009**.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Section 7** comes into force on 1 July 2010.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Sentencing Amendment Act **2009**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 July 2010.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Bail Amendment Act 2009.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
