Proposed amendment

Hon Chris Hipkins, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Clause 36

After clause 36(5) (page 17, after line 14), insert:

- (5A) In section 253C(3)(d), after "appropriate", insert "; and".
- (5B) After section 253C(3)(d), insert:
 - (e) in the case of a wānanga, consult with such persons or bodies who are knowledgeable in āhuatanga Māori (Māori tradition) and tikanga Māori (Māori custom) within a kaupapa Māori pedagogy as the Minister considers appropriate.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper proposes an amendment to *clause 36* of the Education (Tertiary Education and Other Matters) Amendment Bill. The proposed amendment would add a new paragraph to section 253C(3) of the Education Act 1989, requiring the Minister, before deciding whether to grant consent under section 253C(2) for a wānanga to use a certain protected term, to consult with people or bodies who are knowledgeable in āhuatanga Māori (Māori tradition) and tikanga Māori (Māori custom) within a kaupapa Māori pedagogy.
