#### **End of Life Choice Bill**

Proposed amendment to SOP No 259

Simon O'Connor, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Clause 9

In clause 9(3), replace "A must" (page 9) with "A may".

### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends Supplementary Order Paper No 259 amending the End of Life Choice Bill by removing an element of compulsion currently in the legislation – as indicated by the word "must" – in relation to a person who wishes to die by euthanasia or assisted suicide.

It is utterly intolerable that a person be required by law to sign and date the second part of the relevant form – which is the apparent meaning of *subclause 3(a)* as drafted in *clause 9* (including as proposed to be amended by SOP 259) – merely because they have previously expressed a wish to receive assisted dying. This drafting anomaly should be rectified to make it clear that a person is not required to proceed with this stage of the assisted dying process if they have changed their mind.
