The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Government Communications Security Bureau Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day that is 1 month after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That Part 2 be a separate Bill, and that the Part 2 heading be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Inspector-General of Intelligence and Security Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day that is 1 month after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That Part 3 be a separate Bill, and that the Part 3 heading be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Intelligence and Security Committee Amendment Act **2013**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day that is 1 month after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
