Judicial Matters Bill

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*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 3 Bills*

Hon Christopher Finlayson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, Part 1, and Schedules 1 and 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, the *Part 1* heading, and the heading above *clause 3* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

This Act is the Judicial Conduct Commissioner and Judicial Conduct Panel (Deputy Commissioner and Disposal of Complaints) Amendment Act **2010**.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 1A* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 1A* heading and the heading above *clause 15A* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

This Act is the District Courts (District Court Judges) Amendment Act **2010**.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading and the heading above *clause 16* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

This Act is the Judicature (Judicial Matters) Amendment Act  
**2010.**

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which  
it receives the Royal assent.
