Local Government (Auckland Law Reform) Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 3 Bills

Hon Rodney Hide, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, *Part 1*, *and Schedule 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Local Government (Tamaki Makaurau Reorganisation) Amendment Act **2010**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2 and Schedule 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Local Government (Auckland Council) Amendment Act **2010**.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Sections 32 to 42, 45, and 46** come into force on 1 November 2010.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Parts 3AA*, *3*, *4*, *and 5*, *and Schedule 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3AA* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Local Government (Auckland Transitional Provisions) Act **2010**.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Parts 3 and 5** (except **section 138(2)**) come into force on 1 November 2010.
- (2) **Section 138(2)** comes into force on 1 July 2012.
- (3) The rest of this Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
