## Land Transport (Drug Driving) Amendment Bill

Proposed amendment

Hon Julie Anne Genter, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

New clause 2A

After clause 2 (page 5, after line 6), insert:

#### 2A Repeal of this Act

- (1) This Act, and the amendments made by this Act to other enactments, are repealed on the day that is 5 years after the date on which this Act comes into force.
- (2) On the repeal, the provisions amended by this Act are restored as if those amendments had not been made by this Act.
- (3) However, the restoration does not otherwise affect the previous operation of the amended provisions or anything done under them.

### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Land Transport (Drug Driving) Amendment Bill to provide for a sunset clause to apply 5 years after the Act comes into force. This provides a safeguard to ensure that a future Parliament will need to consider whether the new drug-driving law is working and consider any necessary changes as a result of the effects of implementation.
