Smoke-free Environments (Tobacco Standardised Packaging)  
Amendment Bill

*Proposed amendments*

Barbara Stewart, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Schedule*

In the *Schedule*, new *Schedule*, heading to clause 4 (page 17, line 17), replace “**12 weeks**” with “**6 months**”.

In the *Schedule*, new *Schedule*, clause 4(1) (page 17, line 19), replace “12-week” with “6-month”.

In the *Schedule*, new *Schedule*, clause 4(2) (page 17, lines 25 and 26), replace the definition of **12-week transitional period** with:

**6-month transitional period** means the period of 6 months starting at the commencement of the amendment Act

### Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends *clause 4* in the *new Schedule* inserted into the Smoke-free Environments Act 1990 set out in the *Schedule* of the Bill to provide tobacco retailers with a realistic timeframe to manage stock and changeover issues from branded to standardised packaging in order to comply with the regulations introduced by the Bill.
