Subordinate Legislation Confirmation Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Gerry Brownlee, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1 heading* be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Subordinate Legislation (Confirmation and Validation) Act **2015**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That Part 2 and Schedules 1 to 3 be a separate Bill, and that the Part 2 heading be replaced with:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Legislation (Confirmable Instruments) Amendment Act **2015**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 January 2016.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper divides the Subordinate Legislation Confirmation Bill (28—2) into the following 2 Bills:

- Subordinate Legislation (Confirmation and Validation) Bill:
- Legislation (Confirmable Instruments) Amendment Bill.

Division in the manner set out in this Supplementary Order Paper is proposed to be done by the Clerk, and under Standing Order 309(4).
