Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill

Proposed amendment

Joseph Mooney, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Clause 44

In clause 44, after new section 87E (page 26, after line 23), insert:

87EA New Zealand Motor Caravan Association deemed to be selfcontainment certification authority

- The New Zealand Motor Caravan Association is deemed to be appointed as a self-containment certification authority under section 87C.
- (2) **Subsection (1)** applies until the New Zealand Motor Caravan Association resigns that appointment, despite anything to the contrary in **sections 87D and 87E**.
- (3) In this section, **New Zealand Motor Caravan Association** means the New Zealand Motor Caravan Association that is incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill to allow the New Zealand Motor Caravan Association (NZMCA) to certify self-contained motor vehicles, as previously they have done the bulk of voluntary certifications for self-contained vehicles. The NZMCA will be a certifier alongside any other certifiers appointed by the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Board. The Board will not be able to revoke the NZMCA's ability to certify vehicles.
