**Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill**

*Proposed amendment*

Joseph Mooney, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

*Schedule*

In the *Schedule*, new *Schedule 1AA*, after *clause 7* (page 45, after line 22), insert:

Subpart 3—Review of Amendment Act

**8 Review of Amendment Act**

- (1) The Department and the Department of Internal Affairs must, within 1 year of the end of the transitional period,—
  - (a) review the operation of the Amendment Act, since the date of its commencement, in so far as it relates to its effect on—
    - (i) costs to people freedom camping; and
    - (ii) the usage of permitted freedom camping areas; and
    - (iii) waste, generated while freedom camping, being deposited in and on permitted freedom camping areas (other than into an appropriate waste receptacle); and
    - (iv) the proportion of people freedom camping using self-contained motor vehicles.
  - (b) prepare a report on the review for the Minister of Tourism.
- (2) The review must include recommendations to the Minister of Tourism on whether any amendments to the Act are necessary or desirable.

- (3) As soon as practicable after receiving the report, the Minister of Tourism must present a copy of that report to the House of Representatives.

### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill to require the Minister of Tourism to present a report to the House 1 year after the end of the transition period on the costs and effects of the legislation.
