Spatial Planning Bill

Proposed amendments

Hon David Parker, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 7

In *clause 7*,—

- (a) after “tikanga” (page 7, line 14), insert “Māori”;
- (b) after “mātauranga” (page 7, line 15), insert “Māori”.

Clause 56

Replace *clause 56(2)* (page 40, lines 4 to 7) with:

- (2) The regional planning committee must prepare a report for each financial year and make it publicly available within 3 months after the end of the financial year to which the report relates.

Clause 58

In *clause 58(1)(c)*, replace “(including an additional utility operator)” (page 41, line 10) with “or other applicant”.

Replace *clause 58(2)(a)(iii)* (page 41, lines 21 to 23) with:

- (iii) in the case of a network utility operator or other applicant, the performance of its responsibilities under an implementation plan; and

Clause 64

In *clause 64(1)(e)*, replace “(including additional utility operators)” (page 45, line 22) with “or other applicants”.

Schedule 2

In *Schedule 2, clause 2*, definition of **joint management agreement**, replace “provisions” (page 52, line 19) with “provision”.

In *Schedule 2, clause 3(4)(b)*, after “**subpart 11**” (page 54, line 39), insert “**of Part 1**”.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Spatial Planning Bill as follows:

- *clauses 7, 58, and 64 and clause 2 of Schedule 2* are amended so that the wording and terminology in these clauses is consistent with the **Natural and Built Environment Act 2022**:
- *clause 56* is amended to ensure that all regional planning committees have the same deadline for reporting on an implementation plan:
- *clause 3(4)(b) of Schedule 2* is amended to correct a cross-reference.
