Proposed motion to divide Bill into 4 Bills

Hon Simon Power, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Parts 1 and 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words and *clauses 1 and 2* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Reserve Bank of New Zealand Amendment Act **2009**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Securities Markets Amendment Act **2009**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 4* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Personal Property Securities Amendment Act **2009**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 5* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 5* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Securities Amendment Act **2009**.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
