Trade Marks (International Treaties and Enforcement) Amendment Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Simon Power, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
 - This Act is the Trade Marks Amendment Act **2009**.
- 2 Commencement
- (1) Sections 3, 4 to 10, 12 to 16, 18 to 20, and 22A to 27 come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made appointing different dates for different provisions and different purposes.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Copyright Amendment Act 2009.

- 2 Commencement
- (1) **Sections 28, 30, 32 to 34, 36, 38, and 39** come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made appointing different dates for different provisions and different purposes.
