

## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, No. 4, 1865.

## IN THE TWENTY-NINTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN VIOTORIA.

## ANALYSIS:

I. Short Titile.
2. Appropriation of public revenues for the period from the 1st day of July, 1865, to the 31st day of December, 1865, inclusive as per Schedule A.
3. Provincial Treasurer to issue upon warrant by the Superintendent.
4. Provincial Treasurer shall be allowed credit for sums expended as per Schedule B, from 16th January, 1865, up to the 31st day of May, 1865.
5. Persons in possession of public funds of the Province, to pay same to Treasurer, or such other person as Superintendent shall direct.

An Ordinance to provide for the further Appropriation of the Revenue Title. for the period from 16th January, 1865, to 31st May, 1865, and for the general appropriation of the Revenue for the period from 1st July, 1865, to 31st December, 1865.

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of South- Preamble. land with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:

1. The short Title of this Ordinance shall be the Appropriation Ordinance No. 4, 1865.

2. Out of the public revemues of the said Province there may be issued and applied for the public service of the Province and for defraying the charge of the Government thereof for the period commencing on the 1st day of July 1865 and ending on the 31st day of December 1865 in manner set forth in the Schedule A to this Ordinance any sum or sums of money not exceeding the sums in such schedule specified amounting in the whole to the sum of seven thousand four hundred and seventy-four pounds one shilling and fivepence.

Provincial Treasurer to issueupon svarrant by the Superintendent.

Provincial Treasurer shall be allowed credit for sums expended as per schedule B from 16 Jan. 1865 to 31st day of May, 1865.
3. The Provincial Treasurer shall issue from time to time any sum or sums of money not exceeding the sums in such schedule severally specified to such persons and in such proportions as the Superintendent shall by any warrants under his hand from time to time direct and shall be allowed credit in his accounts for all sums so paid by him in pursuance of such warrants and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been paid shall be a full discharge for the sum or sums for which such receipts shall be given.
4. And whereas in defraying the charge of the Provincial Government and in the Public Service of the said province for the period commencing the 16th day of January, 1865 and ending the 31st day of May 1865 certain sums of money amounting in the whole to the sum of three thousand one hundred and forty-seven pounds seven shillings and elevenpence were issued and paid by the Provincial Treasurer in pursuance of warrants under the hand of the Superintendent and such sums were paid on account of the services set forth in the schedule $B$ to this Ordinance but were not included in any Ordinance for the appropriation of the public revenue of the said Province; Be it therefore enacted that the Provincial Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts for all sums of money so issued and paid by him on the several accounts set forth in the Schedule B hereunto annexed and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums of money shall have been paid under such warrants shall be a complete discharge for the sum or sums of money for which such receipts shall have been given.
5. Every person who shall have possession of any Public Funds

Persons in possession of public funds of Province to pay same to Treasurer or/such other person as Superintendent shall direct.
