An Ordinance to amend the "Sheep Ordinance 1866 Amendment Title

WHEREAS by a clerical mistake the word "and" in the third Preamble
line of the third Section of the said Ordinance was inserted in
lieu of the word "or" and whereas it is expedient to correct such
mistake.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Pro-
vince of Southland with the advice and consent of the Provincial
Council thereof as follows:

1. The Short Title of this Ordinance shall be the "Sheep Ordinance 1866 Amendment Ordinance 1867 Amendment 1868."

The third Section of the said "Sheep Ordinance 1866 Amendment Ordinance 1867," shall be read and construed as if the word "and" in the third line of such Section had been struck out and the word "or" inserted in lieu thereof.
