An Ordinance to appropriate Money for the Public Service for the Province of Taranaki for the period of Six Months commenced the 1st January 1866 and ending the 30th June 1866. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for defraying the charge of the Provincial Government of the Province of Taranaki for the period of Six Months commenced the 1st January 1866 and ending the 30th June 1866 BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :— Preamble.

1. For defraying the charge of the Provincial Government of the said Province for the period of Six Months commenced the 1st January 1866 and ending the 30th June of the same year there may be issued and applied out of the Revenue of the said Province for the several purposes and services specified in the Schedule hereto a sum not exceeding £6,932 16s. 11d. Grant for certain charges in Schedule.

2. And whereas the hereinafter mentioned sums amounting to £215 0s. 3½d. were for the year 1865 under the warrant of the Superintendent issued and applied for the purposes hereinafter mentioned in excess of any sums appropriated for such Provision for certain charges for the year 1865.
