AN ORDINANCE *to appropriate money for the Public Service of* Title.  
*the Province of Taranaki for the period of eight months ending*  
*30th June 1870.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for defraying the <sup>Preamble.</sup> charge of the Provincial Government of the Province of Taranaki for the period of eight months ending 30th June 1870. BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :—

1. For defraying the charge of the Provincial Government <sup>Grant for</sup> of the said Province for the period of eight months commenced <sup>services</sup> on the 1st November 1869 and ending on the 30th day of June <sup>specified in</sup> 1870 there may be issued and applied out of the revenue of the <sup>Schedule.</sup> said Province for the several purposes and services specified in the Schedule hereto the sum of £5,284 10s. 5d.

And whereas the hereinafter mentioned sums amounting to £427 2s. 11d. were for the year 1868-9 and £55 18s. 9d. for the year 1869-70 under the warrants of the Superintendent issued and applied to purposes in excess of any sums appropriated for such purposes and whereas the said several expenditures were necessary to the public service. Be it further enacted that the said several expenditures shall be deemed and taken to have been made under the authority of this Ordinance and the Provincial Treasurer shall take credit for the said sums accordingly that is to say
