# CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS ORDINANCE, 1856.

IN THE TWENTIETH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN VICTORIA.

SESSION III., No. 6.

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORISE THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN LINES OF ROAD.

### ANALYSIS.

Preamble.

- 1. Superintendent empowered construct specified roads.
- 2. Fee simple of the soil to vest in

Superintendent.

3. Superintendent required to issue Land Scrip in compensation of owners and occupiers.

Title.

An Ordinance to authorise the construction of certain Lines of Road.

WHEREAS it having been in contemplation under and by virtue of the provisions of an Ordinance of the Governor-in-Chief and late Legislative Council of New Zealand being No. 15 of the eleventh Session of the said Council and commonly known as the New Zealand Company's Land Claimants Ordinance to carry through the sections specified in the Schedules to this Ordinance certain lines of public road particularised in the same Schedules and the compensation payable in Government Scrip to the owners and occupiers of the lands required for the construction of such roads hath been fixed in the manner provided by the said Ordinance at the sums set opposite the respective names of such owners and occupiers in the said Schedules but such Scrip hath not been issued and doubts exist whether the same can now legally be issued by the Governor of the Colony And whereas it is expedient that the Superintendent of the Province should be authorised to cause the aforesaid lines of road to be constructed and to issue to the aforesaid owners and occupiers the amount of Government Scrip fixed for their respective compensation as aforesaid And whereas the said lines of road have been delineated on a map constructed for that purpose and deposited in the office of the Commissioner of Crown Lands at New Plymouth in which map the said lines of road are coloured pink BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of New Plymouth with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :-

1. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent to cause a road Superintendent to to be constructed upon and across each of the sections specified construct specior referred to in the Schedules to this Ordinance in the line fied roads. indicated for that purpose on the said map in manner aforesaid and to cause to be executed upon the said sections all necessary works for that purpose.

- 2. The said roads shall be public roads and the fee simple of Fee simple of the the soil thereof free from all incumbrances shall forthwith vest Superintendent. in the Superintendent and devolve upon his successors in office in like manner as if the same had been duly granted to him by the Governor as a Public Reserve under the provisions of the Public Reserves Act 1854.
- 3. The Superintendent shall forthwith issue to the several Superintendent persons named in the said Schedules respectively Scrip to the Land Scrip in amount set opposite their respective names in the same Schedules compensation of which we have a supposed to the several separate sequences of the several sequences and several sequences are several sequences. which shall be available in the purchase of the Waste Lands of occupiers. the Crown within the Province in like manner and on the same terms and conditions as other Government Scrip issued in respect of the settlement of New Plymouth is now by law available for such purpose.
