AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORISE THE SUPERINTENDENT TO APPOINT A COMMISSION TO INQUIRE INTO AND CONSIDER WHAT SYSTEM OF EDUCATION SHOULD BE ADOPTED FOR THE PROVINCE.

An Ordinance to authorise the Superintendent to appoint a Commission to inquire into and consider what system of Education should be adopted for the Province.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient that an inquiry should be instituted as to the best system of Education to be introduced into the Province and for that purpose that a Commission should be appointed BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of New Plymouth with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—
