AN ORDINANCE TO VEST IN THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE PROVINCE OF NEW PLYMOUTH CERTAIN POWERS AUTHORITIES HERETOFORE VESTED IN AND EXERCISED BY THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR, OR OFFICER ADMINISTERING THE GOVERNMENT OF NEW ZEALAND.

ANALYSIS.

An Ordinance to vest in the Superintendent of the Province of New Title. Plymouth certain powers and authorities heretofore vested in and exercised by the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Officer Administering the Government of New Zealand.

Whereas by various Ordinances enacted by the Governor and Preamble. Lieutenant-Governor of New Zealand with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof specified in the Schedule hereto annexed certain powers and authorities are vested in the Governor or Lieutenant-Governor or in the Officer Administering the Government of New Zealand and it is expedient that such powers and authorities should as regards the Province of New Plymouth be vested in and exercised by the Superintendent thereof BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of New Plymouth with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :--

1. That all powers and authorities which by the several Certain powers Ordinances specified in the Schedule hereto annexed have been in Governor or heretofore vested in the Governor Lieutenant-Governor or in Lieut. Governor to be vested in the Officer Administering the Government of New Zealand Superintendent.

shall and may within the Province of New Plymouth be vested in and exercised by the Superintendent of the said Province Provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed to limit or control the Governor of New Zealand in the exercise of any power or authority heretofore specially vested in the Governor by the authority of the said Ordinances.

Short Title.

2. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the "Empowering Ordinance, 1857."
