AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ERADICATION OF FURZE GROWING ON PUBLIC ROADS.

An ORDINANCE to provide for the eradication of Furze Title. growing on public roads.

Whereas it is expedient to make it compulsory on the oc- Presmble. cupiers or owners of lands abutting on public roads to remove obstructions to the traffic on such roads caused by the spread of Furze from such lands. Be it enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:-

1. If the land on both sides of any road or street shall be hedge on both or formerly have been divided from such road or street by a sides of road Furze hedge the occupier or in case there shall be no occupier each occupier the owner of the land on each side shall be answerable for the clearing away and destroying of Furze on such road or street for half the width thereof adjoining to the land occupied or owned by him and the notices to be given by the said Commissioners or Clerk as provided by the preceding clause shall be made out accordingly.

Trimmings of hedges de not trimmings of any hedge branches of trees or other rubbish to be thrown upon a public road or street and shall neglect to remove the streets.

same within two weeks from the receipt of a written notice so to do from two or more of the Road Commissioners for the District in which such road or street is situated or from the Clerk of the said Town Board the said Commissioners or Clerk may cause such trimmings branches or rubbish to be removed and the cest of the removal of the same and all expenses attendant thereupon shall be recoverable accordingly.

4. The short Title of this Ordinance shall be the "Furze". Ordinance, 1868."
