AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRAIN THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE PROVINCE OF TARANAKI FROM MAKING CONTRACTS WITH MEMBERS OF THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL AND GOVERNMENT OFFICERS OF THE PROVINCE OF TARANAKI BEING MEMBERS OF THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL FROM RECEIVING PAY.

## ANALYSIS:

Title.
Preamble.

1. Superintendent not to enter into 2. Short Title.

An Ordinance to restrain the Superintendent of the Province of Titte-Taranaki from making contracts with Members of the Provincial Council and Government Officers of the Province of Taranaki being Members of the Provincial Council from receiving pay.

WHEREAS it is expedient that members of the Provincial Council Preamble, of the Province of Taranaki should not hold offices and places of profit in departments of the Government of the Colony or Province and should not be engaged in private contracts with the Government.

Superintendent on the part of the Government to enter into or to authorise any one on his behalf to enter into any private contract or agreement with any person or to confer any appointment upon any person being at the date thereof a member of the Provincial Council by which such person shall become entitled to receive directly or indirectly any sum or sums of money of the public Revenue and such private contract or agreement shall be ab initio and shall have the incidents of an illegal contract and any member of the Provincial Council making or carrying out such private contracts or agreements shall be liable to a penalty of One Hundred Pounds to be recovered in a summary way by any person who may sue for the same Provided always that nothing in this Ordinance shall affect the appointment of the Provincial Secretary Provincial Treasurer Waste Lands Commissioner Provincial Solicitor and the Speaker of the Provincial Council or prevent any member of the Council from accepting and receiving payment for any contract which has been opened to public competition by tender.

Short Title. 2. The Short Title of this Ordinance shall be the "Government Offices and Contracts Ordinance 1869."
