WHEREAS by Deed of Grant bearing date the 20th day of August 1858 the unalienated lands within the Town site of New Plymouth are vested in the Superintendent under the provisions of "The Public Reserves Act 1854" upon certain trusts in the Grant described And whereas by Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Taranaki intituled the "Iron Sand Lease Ordinance 1858" a lease of part of the said recited lands was executed by the Superintendent to Edward Morshead for a term of twenty-three years And whereas it is in the said lease provided that in case of the nonperformance of certain conditions in the said lease expressed it should be lawful for the said Superintendent with the approval of the Provincial Council of the said Province to be expressed. by a resolution of the same to enter upon the lands and premises thereby described and absolutely determine the said lease anything therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding

And whereas in consequence of the forfeiture of the said lease by the said Edward Morshead the same was determined by the Superintendent and it is expedient to repeal the said recited Ordinance and to make other provision in lieu thereof BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :--
