IN THE THIRTY-NINTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN VICTORIA.

ANALYSIS:

Preamble.
1. Short Title.

2. Superintendent may exchange land for portions of Mount Eliot.

An Ordinance to authorise the Superintendent of the Province of Taranahi to exchange portions of certain Public Reserves.

WHEREAS by Deed of Grant bearing date the 20th day of Preamble. August 1858 the roads streets and squares in the Town of New Plymouth are vested in the Superintendent under the provisions of an Act of the General Assembly intituled "The Public Reserves Act 1854" upon trust in the said Deed mentioned And whereas by Deed of Grant bearing date the 27th day of February 1860 part of the Mount Eliot Reserve in the said town was vested in the Superintendent under the provisions of the same Act upon the trusts in the said deed declared And whereas by Deed of Grant bearing date the 16th day of April 1869 the land between high and low water mark in front of the said town is vested in the Superintendent under the provisions of the same Act upon trusts in the said Deed stated And whereas by an Ordinance intituled "The Harbour Trust Ordinance 1866" a portion of Brougham-street was diverted from the specific purposes on which it was held under Deed of Grant dated the 20th day of August 1858 and added to the

part of Mount Eliot Reserves granted the 27th day of February 1860 And whereas it is expedient that portions of the said reserves shall be disposed of to Her Majesty for railway purposes by way of exchange for the ungranted portion of Mount Eliot Reserves BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:-

Short Title.

1. The short title of this Ordinance shall be "The Public Reserves Exchange Ordinance 1875."

Superintentendent may exchange land for portions of

2. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent to dispose of the several portions of land described in the Schedules 1 2 and 3 hereto and convey the same to Her Majesty by way of exchange Mount Eliot, for the remaining portion of Mount Eliot Reserves not granted for any public purpose.

SCHEDULE 1.

All that piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement la. 0r. 23p., and bounded as follows:—Commencing at the north-east corner of allotment 651a, thence by the northern boundary of the said allotment and a line in prolongation of the said boundary to the west side of Broughamstreet 130 links, thence by Brougham-street 98 links, thence in a southwesterly direction at right angles to Brougham-street 95 links, thence in a south-easterly direction 30 links to the northern-most corner of land held under Grant dated 27th February, 1860, thence in a westerly direction 95 links, thence in a north-westerly direction 260 links, thence by a line in a westerly direction 25 links south of the existing Lighter Company's Office and 27 links south of the south-westernmost corner of boat-sheds 535 links, thence northerly at right angles to the last mentioned line 144 links, thence in a straight line to the north-westermost corner of boatsheds 226 links, thence by the said boat-sheds southerly 68 links, and easterly with a line in continuation of them 315 links, thence northerly at right angles 21 links, thence by a straight line in an easterly direction 300 links to the boundary of land held under Grant dated 20th August, 1858, thence by the said boundary to the point first mentioned.

SCHEDULE 2.

All that piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement 91 perches, and bounded as follows:—Commencing at a point on the west side of Brougham-street 812 links from Devon-street, thence northwesterly by the said street 98 links thence at right angles 95 links, thence in a south-easterly direction by a course of 4 chains radius 116 links, and thence by a line at right angles to Brougham-street 34 links, to the point first mentioned.

SCHEDULE

All that piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurment 4½ perches, and bounded as follows:-Commencing at the north-eastern corner of

land granted 27th February, 1860, thence in a south-easterly direction 86 links, thence in a south-westerly direction 43 links, thence north-westerly 61 links, and thence in a northerly direction to the first mentioned point 46 links.
