Whereas by certain Ordinances of the Superintendent and Proximital Council of the Province of Taranaki penalties have been imposed on persons in certain cases but no special provision has been therein made for the recovery of such penalties. And whereas it is expedient that such penalties shall be recovered in a summary way. Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

1.
